

CHECK YOUR CONNECTION

When you are seeking God, and you are believing faithfully and trying to apply God's Word to a situation, and nothing seems to work. It is time to do some checking. God and His Word Works. There is no failure in God. So, who does that leave, us? Here are a few checkpoints to help you find your loose connection.

Check #1 First of all checkup on your own life.

Ask God to place His search light in your heart to check your heart and your life. God's Word Works.

Psalms 139:23-24 New King James Version (NKJV)

²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties;

²⁴ And see if *there is any* wicked way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.

Ephesians 4:26-27 Don't give place to the devil. Be angry but sin not...

Loose connections can be caused by an unforgiving spirit, jealousy, covetousness, envy, strife, lasciviousness, evil desire, stinginess, unforgiven – unconfessed sin, and unresolved anger. Also read I Cor. 11:31, Romans 12:18, Ephesians 4:32.

Check #2 Check up on the Promises God has given you.

What promises from God are you standing on. What Promise has God quicken in your Spirit. You cannot have Faith for something unless you have a Promise from God's Word.

2 Timothy 2:15 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁵ Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

If you are standing for prosperity- 3 John 2, if you are standing for healing- 1 Peter 2:24. Also read Romans 10:17. Find the Promise in the Word of God that deals with your prayer request, and stand on the Word of God

Check #3 Check up on your confessions.

What are you saying? What are the words that are coming out of your mouth? You will never rise any higher than your confession. You will never sink any lower than your confession.

Proverbs 18:21 King James Version (KJV)

²¹ Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Prayers to pray over yourself daily. Ephesians 1: 17-23, Ephesians 3:17-19. Confess what God's Word says about you. Know who you are in Christ.

Check # 4 Check the Arena in which you are fighting.

IF the devil ever gets you in the arena of reasoning and looking at your symptoms, he will defeat you every time. Stay out of the arena of reasoning. Stay in the arena of Faith. Say this: "It does not matter what the situation looks like, it may look like it's not changing but God's Word says.... Then quote the scripture you are standing on.

Hebrews 11:1 King James Version (KJV)

11 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Always stay in the arena of Faith.

Check #5 Check on your Companions and Fellowship.

Check out who you are hanging with. Are you in fellowship with people of Faith? If you constantly fellowship with people who cannot support you in faith, you may find yourself struggling to hold on to your Promise.

Mark 4:24 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

²⁴ And He said to them, Be careful what you are hearing. The measure ^[a][of thought and study] you give [to ^[b]the truth you hear] will be the measure ^[c][of virtue and knowledge] that comes back to you—and more [besides] will be given to you *who hear*.

Check up on loose connections with your Companions and Fellowship.

Check #6 Check up on yourself to see if you are obeying the Scriptures that will bring you victory.

People who live a worldly life and when trouble comes and try to use the Word of God will fail. You must always obey the Word of God.

Philippians 4:6 King James Version (KJV)

⁶Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Ephesians 6:11 King James Version (KJV)

¹¹Put on the whole Armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Read: James 1:22-23, Matthew 7:24-27, James 4:7, Isaiah 53:5, Exodus 23:25

Check #7 Check on your Praise Life to see if you are praising God before you see the answer.

Check to see if you are praising God as if you already had the answer. Psalms 34:1, John 11:41, Joshua 6:5, Romans 4:17. I will Bless the Lord at all times, His Praise shall continually be in my mouth.

After checking for loose connection, just with a minor adjustment as directed by the Lord will put you on the right road. God's Word Never Fails.
